**Use of Princes Road, Weybridge as a short cut by Warburton's lorries.**

I am writing to you on behalf of the Triangle Residents' Group (TRG), which represents residents in all those roads *inside* a triangle formed by Queens Road, Hanger Hill and the London-Portsmouth railway line (excluding Queens Road, Hanger Hill, Heathside and Pycroft Lane).

The purpose of this letter is to ask you to re-route your lorry, which makes deliveries to Tesco on Queens Road, Weybridge and then takes a shortcut along Princes Road, Weybridge, while returning to your depot.

We understand the need for efficiency in organisations, and no doubt routing the lorry in this way may save a few minutes and a few pence worth of diesel. However, the roads in the Triangle are residential and are unsuitable for regular routing by HGVs. Princes Road is effectively reduced to one lane each day by parked cars, as is York Road (south) and Pine Grove contains a narrow and blind bend.

I have enclosed a couple of photographs, taken on different days, to show how inappropriate your lorry's use of Princes Road is.
